



### New Knowledge and Vocabulary

Sewing	Joining or attaching materials using stitches
Stitches	A link, loop or knot made with a needle and thread.
Running stitch	A simple stitch running along the material 
Back stitch	A stitch made from left to right. There appears to be no gap between the stitches. 
Finger puppet	A simple puppet controlled by the finger.
