

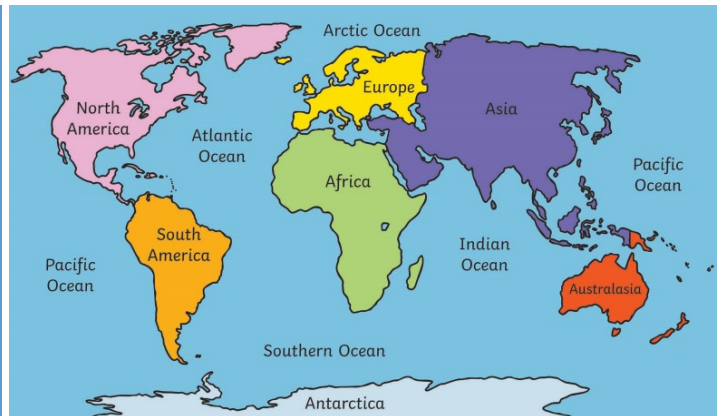

The 7 continents	Asia, Africa, Antarctica, Australasia, Europe, North America, South America
Ocean	A large area of salt water. There are 5 oceans
The 5 oceans	Pacific, Atlantic, Indian, Southern, Arctic
Antarctica	The coldest and windiest continent. Antarctica is the fifth largest continent.
