

New Knowledge and vocabulary

Plant	A living thing that grows in one place such as cherry and juniper trees.
Roots	These absorb water and nutrients from the soil. They also keep the plant stable .
Stem	This helps the water and nutrients move around the plant. Flowers also grow from the stem.
Leaves	These allow the plant to turn sunlight into energy!
Flower	Often colourful , flowers contain seeds.
Seeds	A seed can grow into a new plant.
Deciduous trees	These trees shed their leaves during the autumn and winter months.
Evergreen trees	These trees keep their leaves during the autumn and winter months.
