Why a residential?

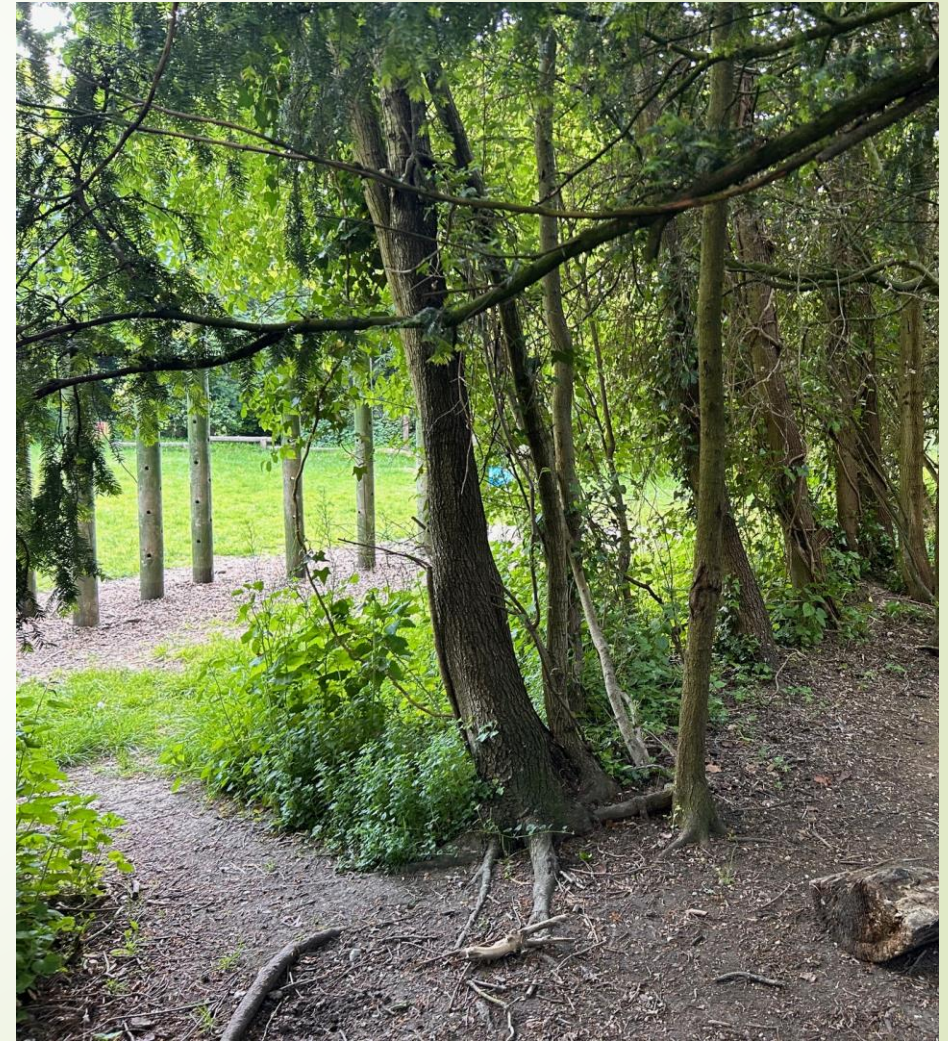
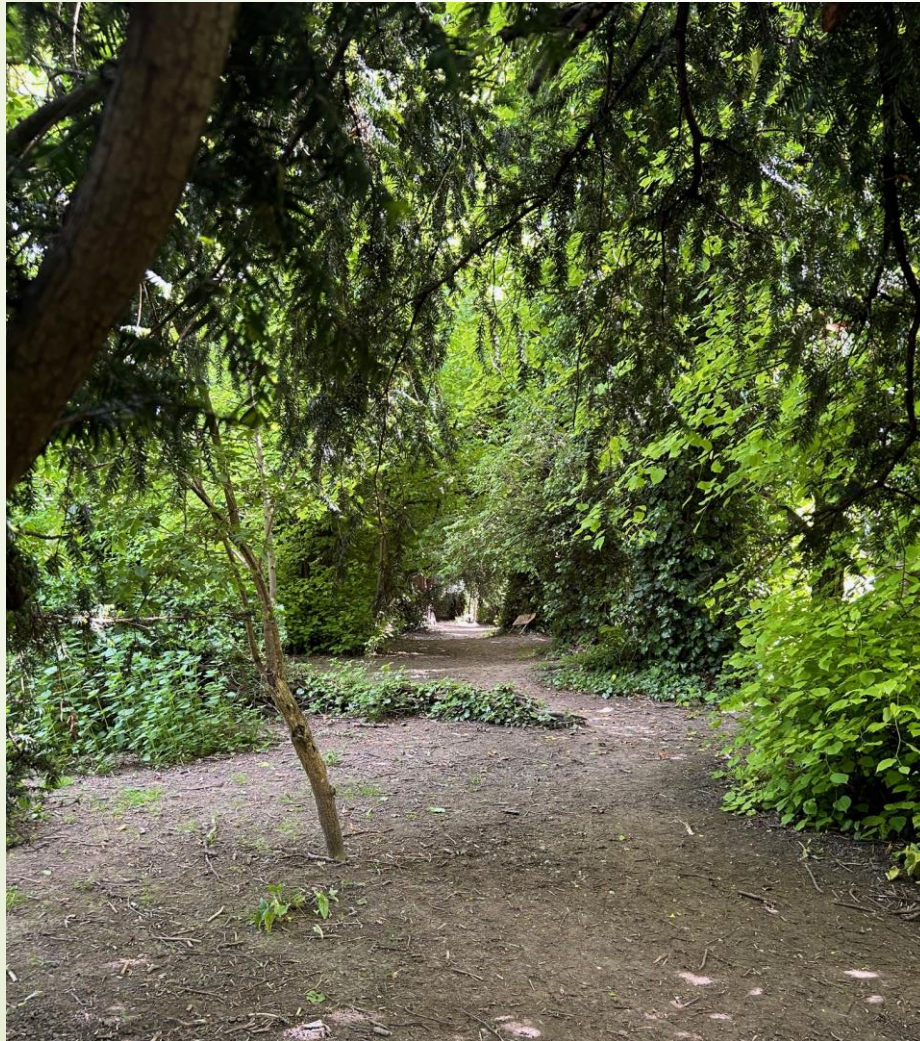
- To give children an experience away from home with their friends.

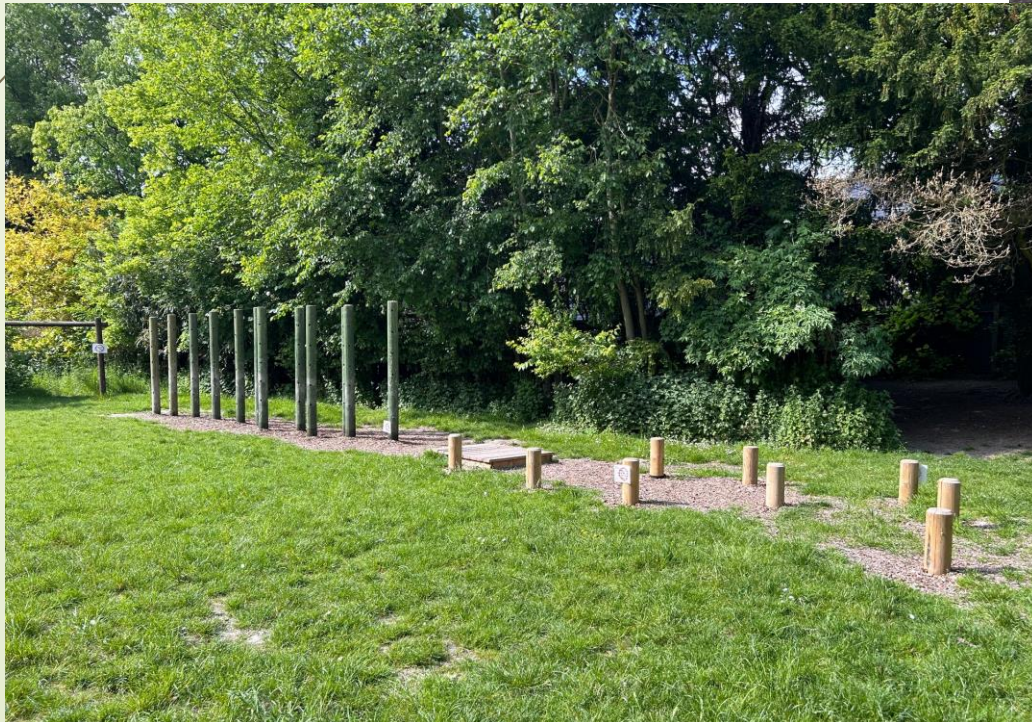


Orienteering

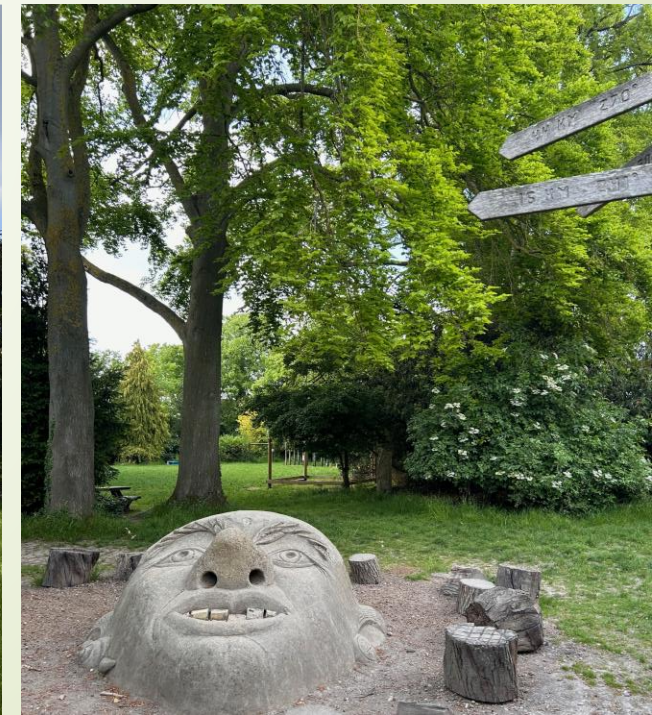
- Using compasses, maps and co-ordinates they will navigate around the site.

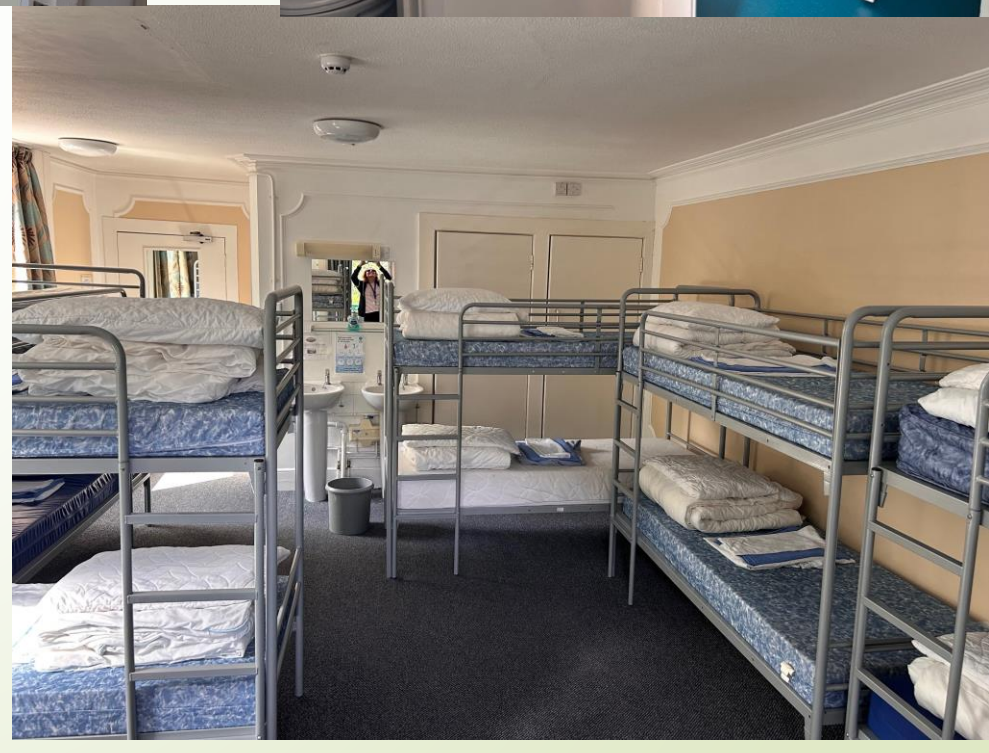
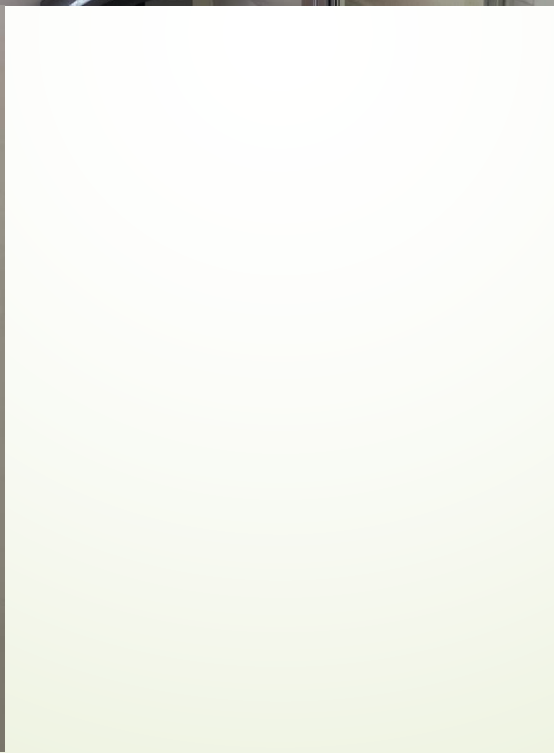
